Upon request, the Office of State Human Resources shall approve a longer period of 6 time; but in no case shall the temporary employment period exceed 12 consecutive months. (Exceptions for students and 7 retired employees: Students are exempt from the 12-months maximum limit. If retired employees sign a statement that 8 they are not available for nor seeking permanent employment, they may have temporary appointments for more than 12 9 months.
