Upon request, the Office of State Human Resources shall approve a longer period of time; but in no 6 case shall the temporary employment period exceed 12 consecutive months. (Exception for students and retired 7 employees: Students are exempt from the 12-months maximum limit. If retired employees sign a statement that they are 8 not available for nor seeking permanent employment, they may have temporary appointments for more than 12 months. 9 "Retired" is defined as drawing a retirement income and social security benefits.)
