RE: Kickoff of Workday Phase I Implementation: Recruiting, Applicant Tracking, Onboarding & Offboarding

OSHR is pleased to announce the kickoff of the Workday Human Capital Management (HCM) – Phase I implementation, which will introduce new and improved processes for recruiting, applicant tracking, onboarding, and offboarding as well as integration of I-9 /E-Verify. Phase I will also include basic organizational charts and position description management, along with the forms, business processes, workflows, reporting and analytics associated to this functionality. This initiative is a significant step towards streamlining HR operations, enhancing the applicant/employee experience, and ensuring greater efficiency in processes and transparency in reporting. Taking advantage of the latest HCM technology advancements will position the retirement of state HR legacy systems and eliminate the need for agency-specific shadow systems.

Consistent and efficient processes will support our HR teams in improving hiring through automated workflows, reduced processing times, and providing consistent and increased data analytics.
